The Bible is like a library made up of 66 books written by many different people over many years.

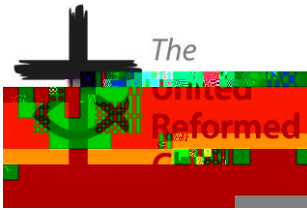
The Old Testament books were written before Jesus was born. They are the holy stories he would have grown up hearing and reading. There are 39 of these.

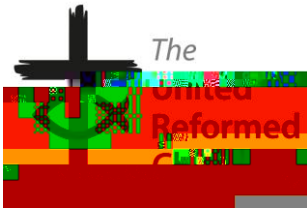

Table Top Discussions

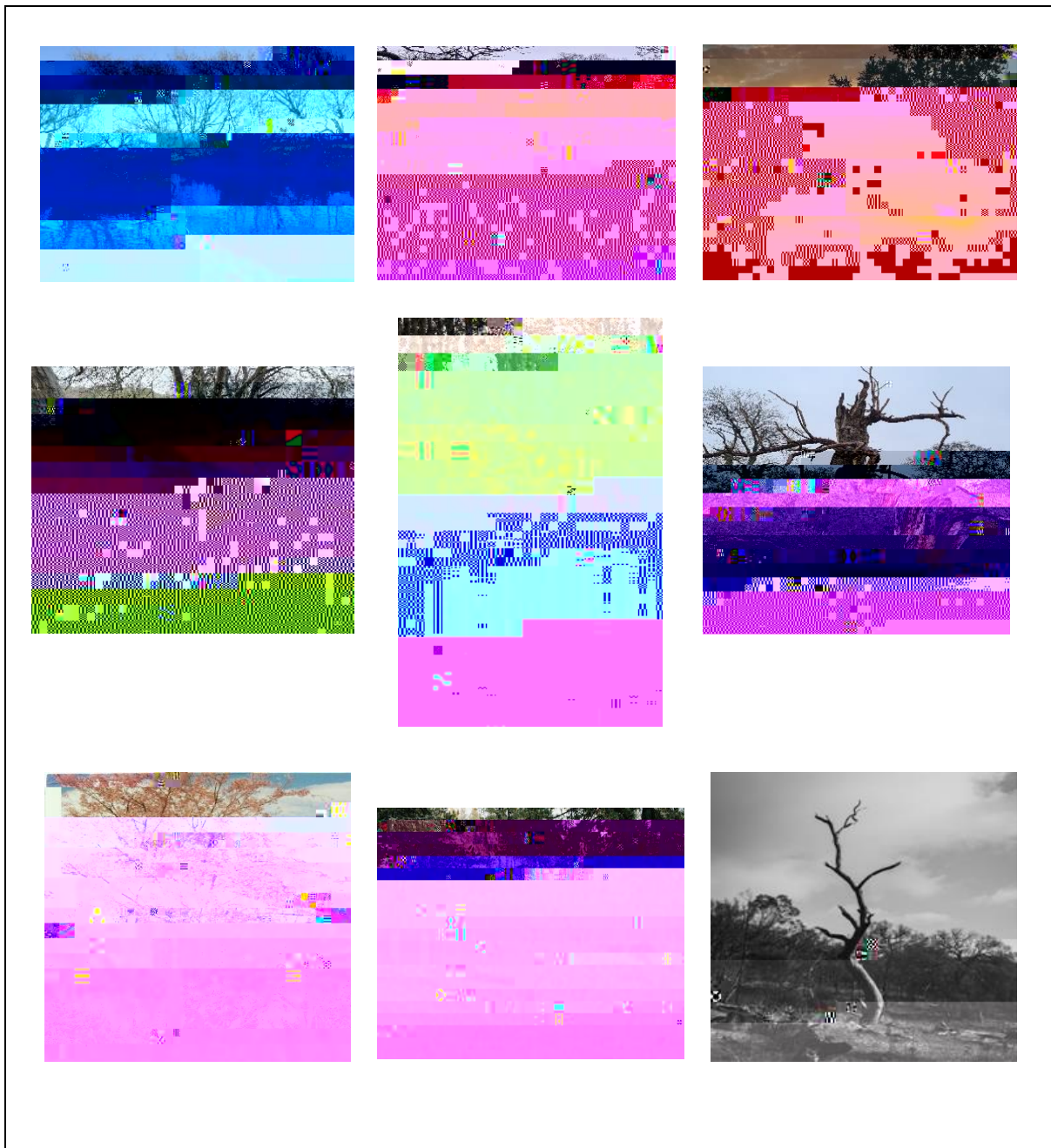
Sit together as a family, and use these questions

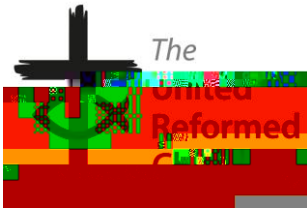
- *Have you ever had a warning from someone, to tell you that you were wrong and needed to put it right? Share your stories together.*

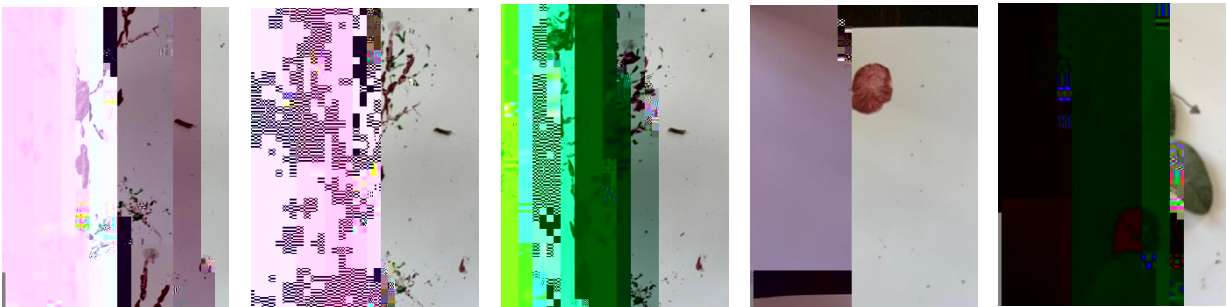
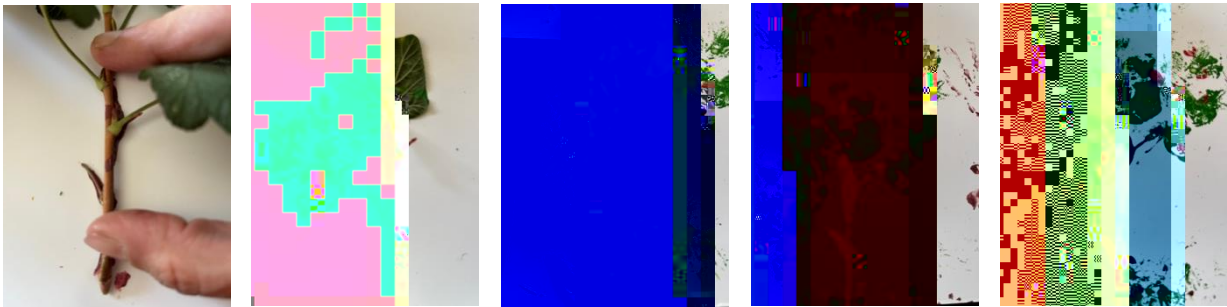
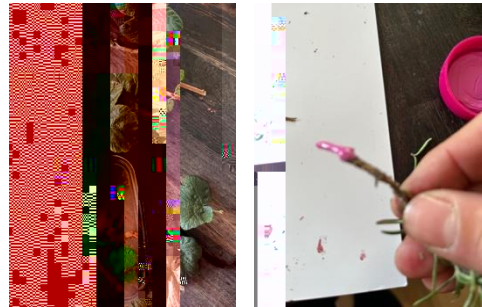
Nature Art

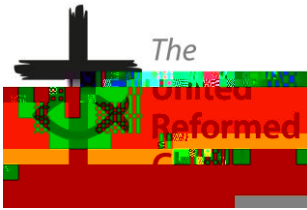
You will need: Leaves, twigs, flowers, and seeds
