Food stickers

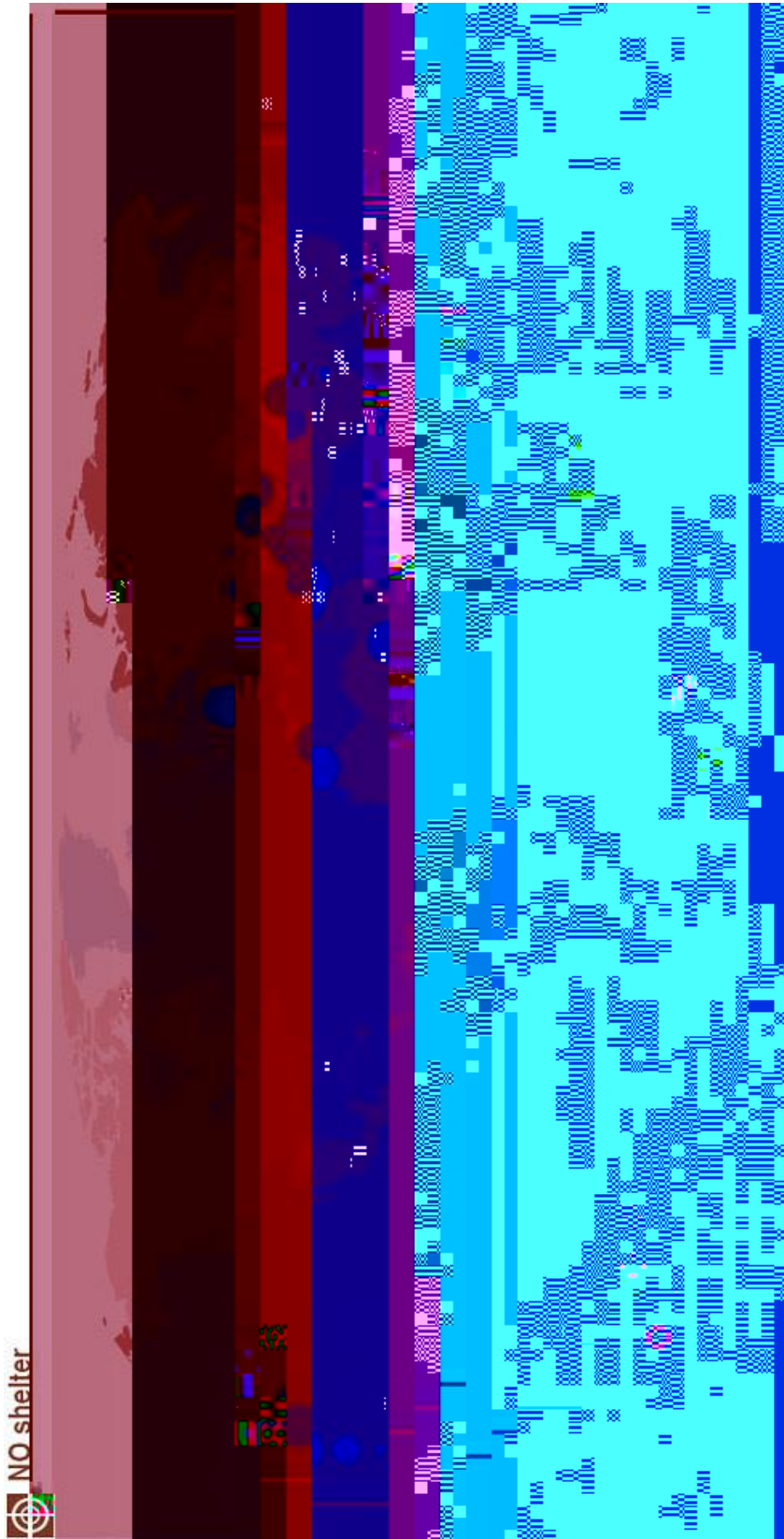
Foodbanks are a common sight now in our churches, supermarkets and community buildings. They shouldn't be needed in the world's 6th largest economy – but they are.
